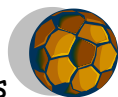

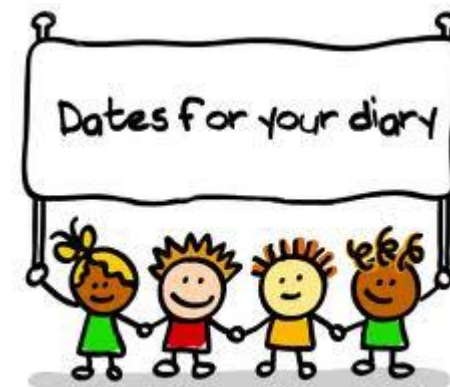

Home time

Please collect children at 3.15pm each afternoon in the small playground.
