We are learning about Minibeasts! We will be reading a lot of books about Minibeasts and we will be taking part in many related play activities. Minibeast stories such as The Hungry Caterpillar, The Lazy Ladybird and Mad about Minibeasts. Please encourage your child to discuss these stories with you at home. Moreover, please encourage your child to write their names as often as possible. Also encourage you child to identify and write numbers 1-10 regularly.

LABELLING CLOTHES

Can you please ensure that all of your child's belongings are labelled, especially jumpers and fleeces. Please ensure their names are written with a permanent marker where they can be seen so that we can return them to their rightful owners!

WEATHER

If it is a really sunny day, all children will need sun cream; a consent form will be sent out to you regarding this. All forms must be completed, signed and returned to the nursery.
