What we will be learning this term

Throughout this first term in Nursery we will be exploring our topic of 'Getting to know each other' and 'Families'.



We will also be settling in the new children to our nursery through our 'getting to know each other' activities. We will also be using our core text Owl Babies to support the children with settling in. The baby owls' wake up one night to find mummy owl had gone but she soon returns, just like their Mums, Dads and Carers do at the end of their nursery session.

Book Bags

Please can you ensure that you purchase a book bag for your child. Monday is book changing day, your child chooses a book and they are able to take it home for a week. We provide you with a yellow reading record book where you are able to make a comment e.g. Sarah really enjoyed listening to Owl Babies.

We ask that you treat our books with respect and if you do notice any damage please let us know. We do have a £5 charge for books that are returned damaged.

Spare Clothes


Please ensure that you provide a change of clothes for your child in case of accidents.

Please collect children at 11:45 am if you are in the morning session and 3:15pm if you are in the afternoon session. If someone other than yourself will pick up your child please let the class teacher or TA and the office know beforehand. **If staff do not recognise the adult picking the child up they will not be able to allow them to collect them.** The person picking up your child should be 16 years or older. **A child will be classified as late if they are not collected by 3.30.pm.** If you collect your child/children after this time, you will be subject to pay our late fee, which is charged at £5.00 .per 15 minutes.
