Home time

Please collect children at 3.15pm each afternoon in the main playground unless they are staying for a club.

If someone other than yourself will pick up your child please let the class teacher or TA and the office know beforehand. **If staff do not recognise the adult picking the child up they will not be able to allow them to collect them.** The person picking up your child should be 16 years or older.

Any child not collected by 3:30p.m will incur a charge of £5 for every hour or part of an
