British Science week begins today! It is a ten-day celebration of science, technology, engineering and maths. At Lucas Vale our celebrations begin on Monday 11th March 2019 and will last the whole week ending on Friday 15th March 2019.

Our theme this year is Journeys.

Throughout the week your child/ren will be taking part in various workshops and classroom-based investigations. For Early Years and Key Stage One, we have a 'Silly Science' workshop where they will see things explode and be guided through a science tour of discovery. For Key Stage Two, they will take part in a 'Virtual Space Tour', where each class blasts off into space, piloting their research vessels around planets and moons, learning about our solar system.
