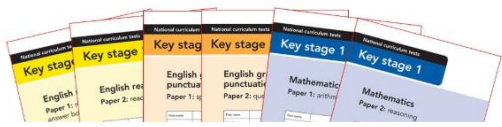


## National Curriculum

## English

This term, we will be writing fictional narratives, poems and diary entries.

We will continue learning how to punctuate our sentences accurately with capital letters, full stops, commas, question marks and exclamation marks. We will also be reviewing our knowledge and understanding of grammar (verbs, adjectives, nouns, pronouns, adverbs, past and present tense).

## History

This term, we will be learning about The Great Fire of London and Samuel Pepys. We will continue to develop an awareness of the past using subject specific vocabulary for everyday historical terms. We will ask and answer questions whilst choosing and using parts of stories and sources to to further enhance our understanding about the key features of the event.

## Mathematics

This term we will be exploring fractions, shape and measurements which includes time, money and dates. We will develop a range of strategies to assist us when answering reasoning and problem solving.

Year two - Spring term

## PE

This term we will be learning Gymnastics. We will be developing our flexibility, strength, technique, control and balance.

## Science

Our topic this term will be exploring the use of everyday materials. We will investigate, experiment, name, discuss and raise questions about a wide variety of everyday materials so that the children become familiar with the names of materials and their properties.

## RE

This half term we will be focusing on what is considered as right and what is considered as wrong. Next half term will learn about Easter and symbols associated with Easter. We will look at the different ways that Easter is celebrated around the world, Jesus' death, burial and resurrection and what the symbols of Easter represent.
