

### National Curriculum

Children will continue to be taught all topics on the curriculum. As far as we know, SATs will be going ahead as usual. Please continue to support us and your child to ensure they are ready.

### Reading

We encourage all children to read at home every day. Please ensure that your child is being read with or independently reading at home to develop your child's language skills. Reading records must be filled out, **using the guide stuck in your child's** reading record. We will keep a record of this. Please note that children will be in-charge of changing their own reading book once they have completed it.

### Home learning

Year 6 will receive multiple pieces of home learning **every Wednesday** and **due every Monday**, to support current learning.
